Theft of Motor Vehicles

Please note the following information:

On Feb 27, 2008 at 0239 hours officers observed two individuals slinking away from a vehicle. When the pair noticed the officers they fled on foot but were captured by police. A subsequent interview with the suspects revealed that he and his cohorts were actively trolling through apartment complexes seeking cars which had been left idling to warm up. Suspects stated that after the vehicles were stolen they would move them to an unassuming parking lot and leave them for a length of time in case the cars were tracked with OnStar or other GPS type software. They would then return later to pick up the vehicles if they hadn't been recovered by police.

There may be additional suspects associated with these crimes. Please be on the look out for suspicious parties hanging around parking lots or if you notice a suspicious car please call 911 to see if it has been stolen.
